What is Redland Community Centre Inc?



Redland Community Centre is a non-profit community based organisation with centres in Capalaba and Cleveland. We are endorsed by the Federal Government as a public benevolent institution. Donations of \$2.00 or more are tax deductible.

The Centre generally provides services to people in the Redland City area, including the Bay Islands, and the suburbs of Wynnum/Manly.

Assisted by over 70 volunteers, the Centre supports the community through a number of valuable community focussed programs including:

- a 21 place childcare facility
- highly regarded and effective parenting programs
- providing Emergency Relief
- a variety of family and individual support services
- short term generalist and crisis counselling
- a variety of courses, activities and programs
- a meeting place for community groups and complementary agencies.



Some examples of how we improve the quality of life of local people!

In the financial year ending June 2010, the Redland Community Centre managed over 3,000 **Emergency Relief** interviews. More than \$77,000 was distributed to residents in our community to help address shortfalls in basic needs such as food, clothing, medical, energy, transport and other everyday living expenses.

In 2011, we assisted 357 children return to school, equipped just like their peers, through our **Back Pack to School** Project.



We also managed over 700 no-cost counselling visits and conducted a wide variety of courses and activities.

Our 2010 **Christmas Family Package** project helped 134 families, involving 371 children, experience a better Christmas.





We conduct a **Long-term Childcare Centre at Capalaba** which cares for 21 children per day in a home-away-from-home atmosphere.

We currently have vacancies.
